You will also need to give the names of two people who are able to comment on your suitability for this post. One must be your current or last employer. If you've not previously been employed, please provide details of another suitable referee.

The school reserves the right to seek any additional references we deem appropriate.

Please let your referees know that you've listed them as a referee, and to expect a request for a reference should you be shortlisted.

You may also attach your CV to support your application.

For identification purposes, please include a passport style photo with your CV or letter of application.
