Established since 2009, MISY has been providing education for students from Early Years (Nursery and Reception), up to Year 11 (IGCSEs) and Year 13 (A Levels) for many years. At MISY we are proud to be home to a multicultural team of **Educators and Staff from 22 countries**.

In 2018, MISY expanded its presence with a sister school in Mandalay.

Both campuses have been **accredited by Cambridge Assessment International Education** and utilise the English National Curriculum.

In April 2025, MISY achieved International Accreditation from the **Council of International Schools (CIS)**, a globally recognized body that upholds excellence in international education. **MISY is the first and only school in Myanmar to receive international accreditation by CIS**. This is a mark of recognition held exclusively by schools around the world that exemplify high quality standards in international education.

## WELCOME TO MISY EYFS

Here at MISY, we follow the English EYFS framework which sets the standards for all group and school based Early Years providers in England. The **Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)** ensures students have the knowledge and skills to start their school journey.

Students may enter our Nursery Programme from 3 years of age and our Reception classes from 4.



## TEACHING AND LEARNING

*We provide a vibrant learning environment that sparks the students' imagination and nurtures their desire to learn. EYFS is a cross-curricular approach. We teach English through stories, songs, games, art and counting. This includes specialist Art, Music and P.E lessons. To further enhance the curriculum, educational visits are organised to provide real-world experiences and deepen their understanding of key concepts.*

There are seven **Areas of Learning and Development** in the Early Years Curriculum. Each day, students will have opportunities to develop skills across these Areas of Learning with various activities that take place both indoors and outdoors.

### Outdoor Learning

MISY has an extended outdoor space enabling the students to explore nature.

### Having Fun

Play is very important and we generate most of our lessons so that students can learn through play. This approach encourages full participation.

### Phonics

Each teacher-led phonics session comprises four parts: review, teach, practice and apply. This ensures rapid progress in both their reading and writing.

### Tapestry

Tapestry is used as a form of communication between the school and parents.

*Selected EYFS classrooms have specially designed bathrooms attached. There are specialist rooms for Music, Art, Computing, Myanmar and Mandarin.*
