Established since 2009, MISY has been providing education for students from Early Years (Nursery and Reception), up to Year 11 (IGCSEs) and Year 13 (A Levels) for many years. At MISY we are proud to be home to a multicultural team of **Educators and Staff from 22 countries**.

In 2018, MISY expanded its presence with a sister school in Mandalay.

Both campuses have been **accredited by Cambridge Assessment International Education** since 2010 and therefore able to conduct Cambridge examinations on campus. We offer a large range of IGCSE and A-Level subjects.

In April 2025, MISY achieved International Accreditation from the **Council of International Schools (CIS)**, a globally recognized body that upholds excellence in international education. **MISY is the first and only school in Myanmar to receive international accreditation by CIS**. This is a mark of recognition held exclusively by schools around the world that exemplify high quality standards in international education.

## WELCOME TO PRIMARY

Primary consists of Key Stage 1 (Year 1-2) and Key Stage 2 (Year 3-6), with students from ages 5 to 10 respectively.

### **The English National Curriculum**

Primary Students acquire knowledge and skills in line with the National Curriculum in England. We provide a balanced programme which fosters a love for learning that students will carry with them throughout their lives.

Each class is taught by an **experienced expatriate teacher** supported by a well-qualified teaching assistant. All specialist subjects are taught by **specialist teachers**. Students have library lessons and are encouraged to choose books to take home each week.

### **Oxford Reading Tree**

- This reading programme is used to foster early literacy skills. Each level builds on the skills learned before, helping students grow their abilities.

### **English as an Additional Language**

- Students who arrive at MISY with limited English are required to take additional English classes as part of their school day until their level of English improves. We assess their English level using WIDA tests.

## Extra Curricular Activities

- **Educational Field Trips**
  - All classes go on educational trips.
- **Cultural and Academic Celebrations**
  - School-wide celebrations showcase learning excellence through performances and exhibitions, such as International Day, Myanmar Culture Day, and Art Exhibitions to name a few.
- **After School Activities (ASAs) and Sports Coaching**
  - We run a programme of exciting after-school activities and sports coaching.



### **Assessment**

Every year, our students sit a CEM Test to check their achievement against their peers in England. Parents receive a detailed report outlining ways to support their child.

### **Campus Facilities**

Primary students all have allocated classrooms. There are specialist rooms for Music, Art, Computing, Myanmar and Mandarin lessons. The outside facilities include a football pitch and several age-appropriate playgrounds.
